

**Flowdown of U.S. Government Contract Clauses
For Non-Commercial Product or Service Firm Fixed Price (FFP) Purchase Orders**

ATTACHMENT 1: PRIME CONTRACT FLOWDOWN PROVISIONS

1. PURPOSE. This Attachment is incorporated into and made a part of the AM General Solicitation and subsequent Purchase Order ("Agreement"). The following Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) and Department of Defense FAR Supplement (DFARS) clauses are incorporated herein by reference. The date of the FAR/DFARS clause in effect as of the date of the Prime Contract execution shall apply unless otherwise specified.

2. INCORPORATION. Seller agrees to comply with these terms as they relate to its scope of work and to flow these terms down to its lower-tier subcontractors where required by the Prime Contract. Seller shall insert the following provisions in selected lower tier subcontracts, either verbatim or in substance, and by incorporation-by-reference or otherwise as appropriate.

3. SELF-DELETING INAPPLICABLE PROVISIONS. The provisions set forth in this Attachment are included based on their potential applicability to the scope of work. However, if a provision by its own terms or by law does not apply to the specific goods, services, or dollar value of this Purchase Order, such provision shall be considered self-deleting and shall have no force or effect. The inclusion of a provision in this Attachment is not an admission by Buyer that the provision applies to Seller's performance unless the criteria for applicability are met.

4. SUBSTITUTION OF TERMS. Whenever necessary to make the context of the Clauses applicable to the Order, the term "Contractor" shall mean Supplier, the term "Contract" shall mean the Order, and the term "Government", "Contracting Officer" and equivalent phrases shall mean Buyer, except the terms "Government" and "Contracting Officer" do not change: (a) in the phrases, "Government Property", "Government-Furnished Property", and "Government-Owned Property", (b) in the patent Clauses incorporated herein, (c) when a right, act, authorization, or obligation can be granted or performed only by the Government or the Contracting Officer or a duly authorized representative, (d) when title to property is to be transferred directly to the Government, (e) when access to Proprietary Information is required, except as specifically otherwise provided herein, and (f) where specifically modified herein.

5. PRECEDENCE. In the event of an inconsistency between the terms of this Attachment and the main body of the Agreement/Purchase Order, the terms of this Attachment shall govern.
